PUBLIC FIRE PROTECTION SERVICE RATES

For the 376 public fire hydrants now owned and maintained by the York Water District and connected to the District's mains on January 1, 2020, there shall be paid to the District the following Public Fire Protection Charge:

For each public fire hydrant owned and maintained by the District and installed after January 1, 2024, charges will be determined pursuant to Chapter 69 of the Maine Public Utilities Commission's Rules and Regulations.

All public fire hydrants will be cared for and maintained in good working order (unavoidable accidents excepted) by the District. Once any fire hydrant is installed and in operation, the total annual fire protection service charge then in effect will not be reduced should the municipality served order one or more hydrants discontinued. No hydrant shall be installed on mains of less than 6" in diameter.

Should the municipality order any hydrant or hydrants moved to a different location, the municipality shall pay to the Water District all costs of removing and re-installing said hydrant or hydrants.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

Bills under Public and Private Fire Protection are net and will be rendered in advance. On metered bills, the Minimum Charge is in advance, and usage in excess of Minimum Charge is in arrears. Whether the billing is Monthly or Quarterly shall be determined by the Water District

Late Payment charges will be the Maximum amount allowed by Chapter 870 of the Commission's Rules and Regulations

There shall be no additional charge over and above the connection charge for Sprinklers heads as such.

All standpipes and sprinkler pipes shall be so placed as to be readily inspected and if concealed or so arranged with other pipes as not to be readily inspected, dectector meters shall be installed on each service at the expense of the water taker.
